

Privacy Policy

The Olympic Lottery Distributor is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy sets out the basis on which your personal data will be processed by us.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 ("the Act") the data controller is The Olympic Lottery Distributor, 1 Plough Place, London, EC4A 1DE.

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

1. Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site.
2. If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
3. Details of transactions you carry out through our site.
4. Details of your visits to our site and the resources that you access.

Where we store your personal data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored on, equipment located at a third party's premises. Such third parties are located within the European Economic Area. By submitting your personal data you agree to this transfer. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. So, whilst we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot ensure the security of your data transmitted to our site. Any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information we will use strict procedures and security features to prevent unauthorised access.

Uses made of the information

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that the business and assets of the Olympic Lottery Distributor are transferred to a third party in which case we may disclose your personal data to a third party, but we will inform you of such transfer;
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation or in order to enforce or apply to our Terms and Conditions and other agreements; or protect the rights, property, or safety of our firm, our clients, or others. This includes exchanging information

with other companies and organisations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

The best thing you can do is delete the emails and tell your friends and colleagues to do the same.

In order to win the UK National Lottery, you have to buy a ticket, either interactively, via the National Lottery website, mobile phone or interactive television, for which you need a UK address, or a National Lottery retailer. The Olympic Lottery Distributor does not give away prize money.
